Complete Dentures and Partial Dentures

Dentures are designed to replace missing teeth. Dentures take some getting used to, and will never feel the same as your natural teeth. A bulky or loose feeling is not uncommon. Your muscles of your cheeks and tongue adapt to hold your dentures in place.

New Dentures are never the same as a previous denture. Jaw anatomy changes over time, which changes the new denture design. The portion of your jaw that supports teeth slowly disappears once the teeth are gone, this results in changes in jaw shape.

Adaptation by muscles (cheek and tongue) take some time with a new denture. It is often necessary for follow up visits as needed for adjustments and re-fitting. A soft temporary reline material may be utilized for re-fitting your denture when it becomes loose.
